

Mentoring Services

As a mentor, I collaborate with the family to help the learner achieve a predetermined goal -- typically through training in specific writing and/or history skills. This may take the form of meeting each day for a week or once a week for a month.

Different educational goals will dictate different approaches, such as: essays; immersion into a historical period; a class-like environment to study a historical novel; speech writing and delivery; a classic book club, etc.

Through various approaches, learners can advance in such skills as: research, note taking, essay writing, basic home economics, reading classics, primary and secondary source analysis, self-directed learning, development in multiple learning styles, etc.

My ultimate goal as a mentor is to inspire their natural curiosity and develop a lifelong love of learning and history.

Mentoring fees are \$25 per 30-minute session, with a limit of two hours. If you have three to five similarly aged learners you'd like to bring together for a class-like approach, fees are \$25-\$35 per person for each two-hour session.
